EDITING/PROOFREADING CHECKLIST

You should tick off all the checkboxes before obtaining a proofreading service.

Check your grammar

- Spelling errors.
- Capitalization.
- Subject and verb agreement.
- Check for homonyms, words that sound the same, but have different meanings and are spelt differently: (their/there/they're, two/too/to, accept/except, and its/it's. Make sure that you have used the correct word.)

Check your punctuation.

- Use commas correctly
- Apostrophes are used to indicate possession, not plurals.
- Colons (:) and semi-colons (;) are correctly used.
- Quotation marks (') or (") are used consistently.



Have you followed academic guidelines?

- Type font and size (for example Times New Roman size 12)
- Given Line spacing
- Margin width
- Paragraph indentation
- Page numbering
- Headers and footers.

- Correctly apply SLIIT recommended referencing styles (IEEE, APA, Harvard etc.)?
- Include all the texts you have cited in your reference list?
- Arrange references in alphabetical order.
- Check for plagiarism.
